The Town Board of the Town of Dayton, Waupaca County, Wisconsin, by this resolution, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, resolves and orders as follows:

To conserve and promote the public health, safety, convenience, or general welfare, pursuant to ss. 61.35 and 62.23 (6), Wis. Stats., the town amends the official highway map of the town, which changes all of the following:

1. Coach Road; from West Road to the South Entrance of Hartman Creek State Park, more accurately described in the attached CSM; is declared to be a public highway of the Town of Dayton.
2. Parfreyville Road; from County Highway K (northernmost intersection) to the West a distance of .26 miles; is declared to be fully contained in the Town of Dayton including the entire road right-of-way so said road.

The town clerk shall keep the official map at the town hall as an official record of the town.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this resolution as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
